

WHAT DOESN'T WORK: MALE ENGAGEMENT IN MOZAMBIQUE

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1. Men and boys are not yet convinced that giving up power is in their interest
2. Gathering widespread evidence on the attitudes, perceptions, and behaviours of men and boys was not prioritised
3. Male engagement programmes are not sufficiently tailoured to the various power roles that men hold
4. National policies and strategies are non-existent, making programming on male engagement haphazard
